
## Report of the Programmes of Women's Cell and Jagratha Smithi, 2020-2021

## **Cancer Prevention and Healthy Lifestyle**

As part of Cancer awareness an online session on Cancer Prevention and Healthy Lifestyle was organized on 14th December 2020 in collaboration with Sanjeevani: Life beyond Cancer, an NGO based in Mumbai. Ms. Sumki Begum, National Coordinator, outreach programmes Sanjeevani, was the resource person. A total of 93 participants attended the session. 
