

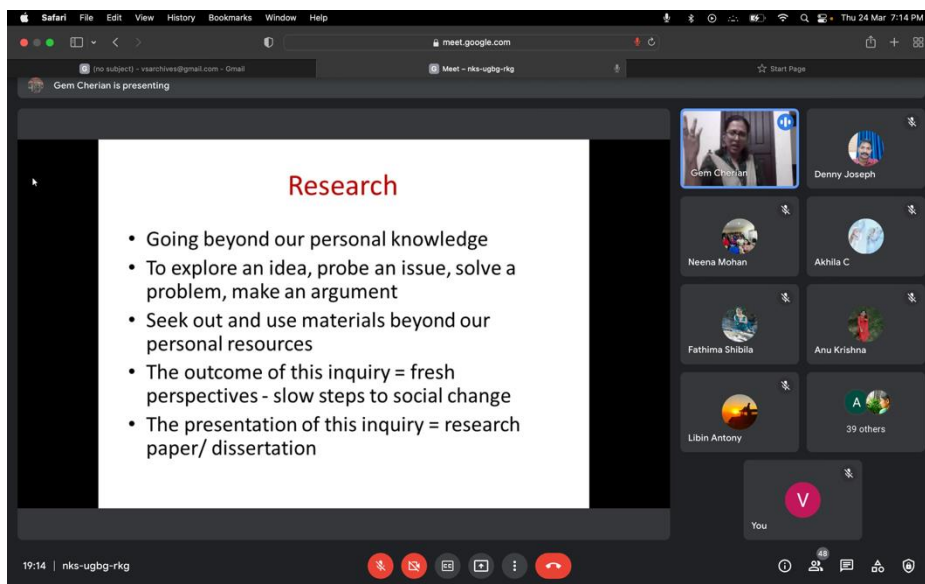
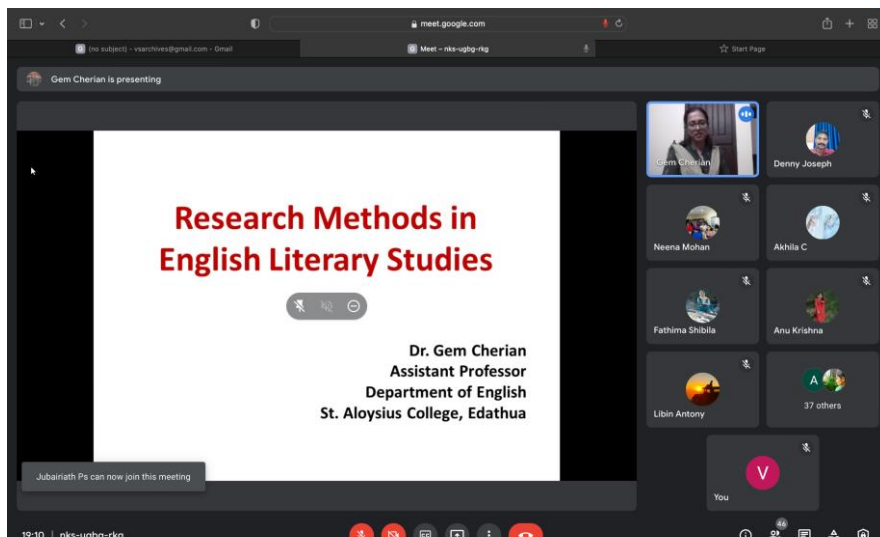
Postgraduate Department of English Government College Mananthavady
